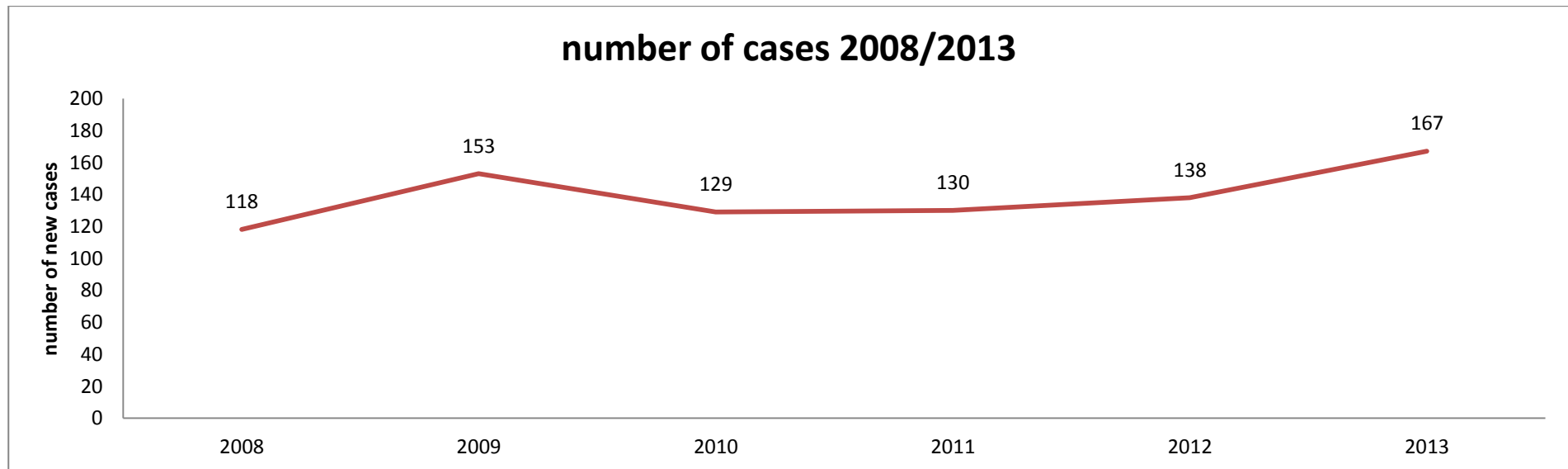


CAM 2013 – FACTS AND FIGURES

In 2013 there was a strong increase in the number of new cases administered by the Milan Chamber of Arbitration compared with previous years. With 167 new cases, CAM has reached the highest number of proceedings administered in the last years.

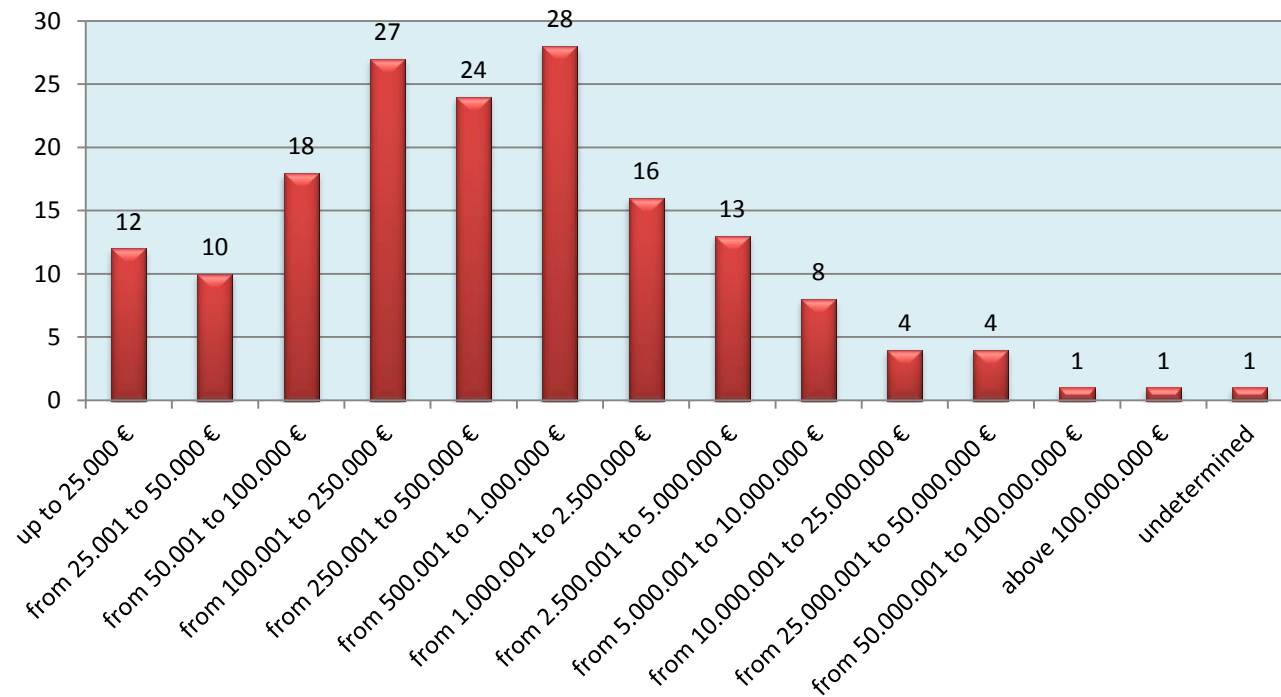
NUMBER OF NEW CASES: 167. 21% increase compared to 2012.



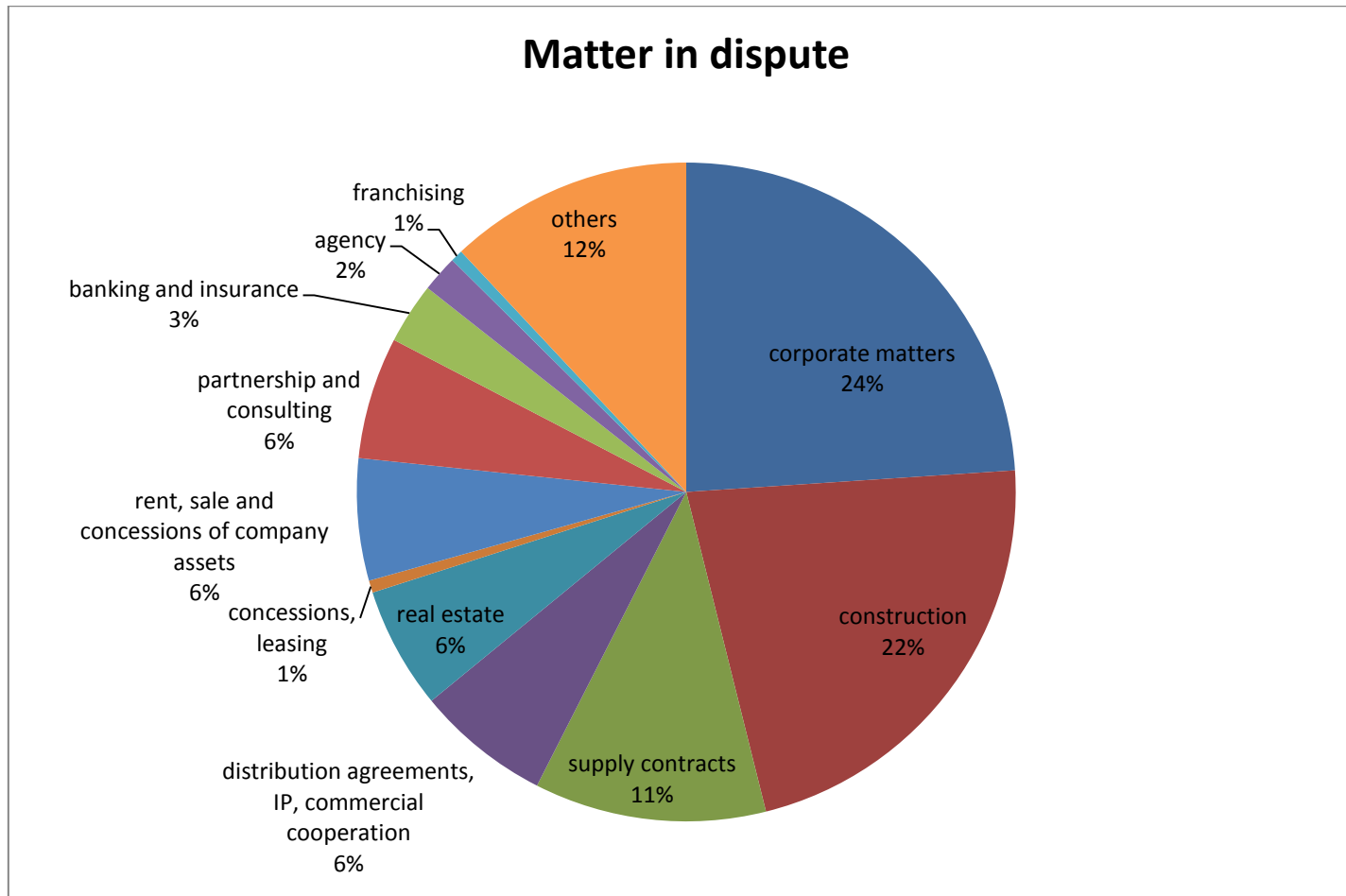
AVERAGE DURATION OF THE PROCEEDING: 12,2 months (from the request for arbitration)

AVERAGE VALUE OF THE DISPUTE: 3.723.764 € (6.708.231 € in 2012). **71%** of the cases had a value of the dispute below 1.000.000 €

MATTER IN DISPUTE: 24% corporate; 22% construction; 11% supply contracts; 6% respectively agreement/IP/trademark, real estate, partnership and consulting, rent/sale/concession of company assets.



COMPOSITION OF THE ARBITRAL TRIBUNAL: 62% Panel 38% Sole Arbitrator (in 2012, 67% Panel and 33% Sole Arbitrator)
