(\*\*) **Not confirmed arbitrators:** 9 arbitrators were replaced as a result of the non-confirmation; 2 arbitrators have not been replaced due to an early termination of the proceedings following the withdrawal of the claims.

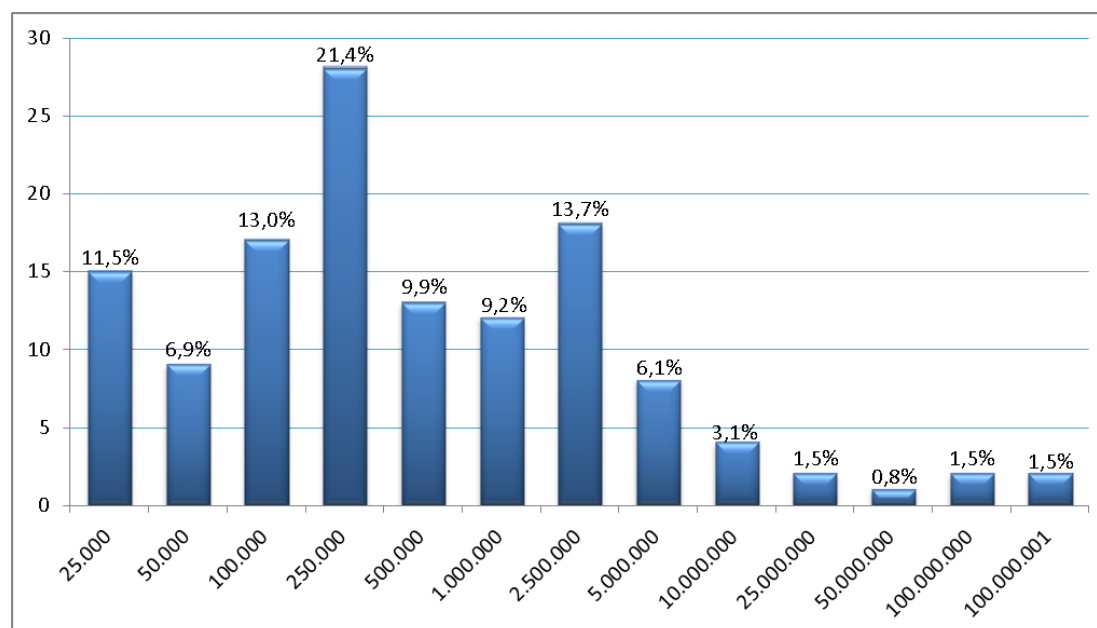
